Grievance Issues

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1. You reported to DCPS CARE that you received an apology from the school in _____, but that your email to the school's Principal, in _____, regarding a change in school policy to ensure this does not happen again did not receive a response.
 2. On _____ School Psychologist _____ reported to DCPS CARE that Fly-by-Light Employee _____ shared that a student with the initials _____ disclosed to Fly-by-Light Employee _____ that she was sexually assaulted by her father.
 3. School Psychologist _____ reported to DCPS CARE that Fly-By-Light Employee _____ informed School Psychologist _____ of a sexual assault involving a student with the initials _____. They then contacted CFSA to file a report regarding your student, Student _____.
 4. School Psychologist _____ reported to DCPS CARE that they contacted CFSA about the wrong student with the initials _____. When they realized your student, Student _____ was incorrectly reported, she contacted CFSA the same day to amend the report. She also contacted you and apologized.
 5. On _____ you reported to DCPS CARE that the school did not take any disciplinary action and that there was no meeting and no follow-up after the _____ incident.
 6. You reported to DCPS CARE that the allegations of sexual assault were supposed to be deleted from your husband's record and you expressed concerns that this was not fully completed.
